

## SKY-SCAPE® INFORMATION SHEET

**1) What is a Sky-Scape®?** A **Sky-Scape®** is a 2'x4' fluorescent light diffuser panel with a sky graphic photographic image printed directly on the material in 4 color process. They simply take the place of existing prismatic lens frosted panels in 2'x4' fluorescent light ceiling fixtures. Each photographic image is artistically designed to diffuse light rays equally so NO definition of bulbs is evident when viewed from the floor. The image is printed on the side facing outward. These extremely durable premium panels carry a life expectancy of 10 years or more before showing any signs of yellowing.

**2) What if it does not fit exactly or if our fixtures are smaller?** You can easily trim **Sky-Scapes®** to fit any size frame under the standard size of 2'x4'. To install, simply lift the frame out of the hinges in the ceiling and remove the existing lens panel. Using the existing lens panel as a template, lay your new **Sky-Scape®** down on the floor image side up. Lay your old one on top over the area you want displayed and mark the new panel for trimming. Trim your new **Sky-Scape®** (**using the trimming tool which comes FREE with each order**) using a metal edged T-square or ruler (safety glasses are recommended) as a cutting edge. There is no need to cut all the way through, just score several times to produce a good deep score line. Then simply snap the excess material off and discard. Peel off the clear plastic backing before installing. Insert the **Sky-Scape®** panel in the frame and replace the frame back into the ceiling fixture.

**3) Do Sky-Scapes® cause any loss of light?** This answer depends on several variables. If you have a large window and lightly colored walls and carpet you probably will not notice any loss. However, if you do not have any natural light source in the room and your walls are a darker color the loss of brightness could measure around 10% less than what you currently have. Due to the heavy foliage in the **Colorado Aspen** panels, they diffuse the light up to about 40% more than the other designs, but create a much warmer light due to the golden leaves in the photograph. **Sky-Scapes®** are designed to diffuse the light rays equally and reduce the undesirable harsh glare of fluorescent lighting. The result is a more soothing, relaxing and esthetic environment for your patients, visitors and yourself! To obtain maximum brightness please read on.

**4) What if brightness is a major factor in a particular room or dental op?** We strongly recommend replacing your existing bulbs with our Vision Plus Color Corrected fluorescent bulbs. **They are available in 2 varieties: T-8 bulbs (32watt, 2950 lumens, 5000 kelvin); or T-12 bulbs (40watt, 3600 lumens, 5000 kelvin).** These bulbs will provide the **brightest** white backlit effect possible and are color corrected. Please be aware that if your bulbs are inconsistent then your sky image being viewed will be inconsistent from one fixture to the next. T-8s are the newer, thinner, more energy efficient bulbs (about 7/8" in diameter), T-12s are older bulbs (about 1 1/4" in diameter); they are not interchangeable.

**5) What is the life expectancy of Sky-Scape® panels?** All images are printed with fade resistant inks. **Premium Sky-Scapes®** are designed for longevity and are estimated to last for 10 years or more. They are **new and improved this year**, extremely durable and shatter resistant. **Sky-Scapes®** are guaranteed for 1 yr. and are intended for use **ONLY** in standard fluorescent light fixture frames (**do not use** with halogen lamps, in window or skylight applications or with other types of bulbs other than fluorescent).

**6) What if I have fluorescent lights but they have 18 aluminum grid squares about 4" deep covering each fixture?** This is called a parabolic cell fluorescent lighting unit. This grid is totally removable and can be replaced by an adaptor frame (powder coated in white) which we sell separately (**called a PCK**) in order to enable you to utilize a **Sky-Scape®** diffuser panel. **DO NOT** place a diffuser panel between the grid and the bulbs. It is too close to the bulbs. The grid unit must be removed and replaced with our adaptor frame (it is not permanently attached to the ceiling, but will rest on the metal dropped ceiling frame with the fluorescent light unit on top). The adaptor frames (PCKs) come 2'x4', 2'x2', or 1'x4'. Prices range from **\$31.95 to \$34.95** for the adaptor frames (shipping/tax additional). **7) What is the refund policy?** Should you decide for some reason that you need to return your **Sky-Scapes®**, they can be returned for a full refund within 10 days of receiving them **ONLY** if they are not damaged in any way or trimmed (pre-trimmed panels are non-refundable). Shipping charges are not refundable and any shipping charges required to return the panels to us are the customer's responsibility. You **must** let us know if you are returning the panels so that we can give you accurate packaging instructions.
